1. You must provide a brief typed bio (one paragraph) with a description of your art piece. This can be emailed to kim.coultis@banff.ca or dropped-off to Community Services by Friday, February 17 with your application for submission.
2. A **\$30 entrance fee** is required to offset the cost of set-up and the opening night reception.
3. **Artwork must be submitted by February 17.** All submissions must be suitably framed, wired and ready to install. Please drop off your submission between 8:30 am – 4:30 pm to:

4. Artwork may be picked up after the Homegrown exhibit from Community Services between Friday, March 30 and Tuesday, April 3 between 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.
5. Artists should plan to attend the **Homegrown Opening Reception at Town Hall on Friday, March 2 from 7 - 9 p.m.**
6. If you are selling your artwork, you will be responsible for all aspects of the transaction, including contacting purchaser, financial agreements and the transfer of art **AFTER** completion of the Homegrown show. There will be no exceptions.
7. Your artwork should be insured, as the Town of Banff will not be held liable for any damage.

8. Please pick up invitations to the Opening Reception from Community Services during the month of February to hand out to friends, relatives and acquaintances.

Waiver of Liability Information

This waiver of Liability between the Town of Banff and the artist waives any liability on the part of the Town of Banff or its employees with regard to a public exhibition by the Artist of his /her works of art (“Works”) to be held at the Town of Banff, Town Hall.

The Artist hereby agrees to hold harmless Town of Banff and/ or its employees and volunteers from any liability for the Artist of the Works including but not restricted to damage to or theft of the Works.

This waiver stipulates that ownership of Works sold during the exhibition shall not be transferred from the Artist to a purchaser until after the Closing Date. Receipts made out to purchasers shall be marked “Deposit on artwork”.

It is hereby understood by and between the Town of Banff and the Artist that the only intention of the Town of Banff is to provide a venue for the exhibition of the Works during the above period and that the Town of Banff can accept no responsibility or liability for the Artists or the Works.
