The Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan provides full coverage for insured physician and specific dental/oral surgical services to all eligible residents of Alberta. It also provides limited coverage for chiropractic, podiatry and optometry services. Premiums are charged for coverage; premium subsidy is available and seniors' coverage is free. Eligibility: new and returning Alberta residents applying for coverage must provide proof of identity, legal entitlement to be in Canada and their Alberta residency. A Personal Health Number (PHN) will be assigned to residents who qualify and are registered. Albertans must provide their PHN when obtaining health services.

The Children's Health Services Team is part of the Community Care program and aims to provide early identification and intervention with children from birth to 18 years, experiencing difficulties in their development. The following programs may be accessed through the child's school or by calling 678-7200.

Speech – Language Pathology – helps to identify and rehabilitate communication disorders including difficulties with articulation, language, fluency and voice.

Occupational Therapy – Development of programs for home and school to increase child's strength, endurance, movement, self-confidence or functional level.

Physical Therapy – Assessment and treatment for children with physical disabilities.
