## Town of Banff- Low-Income Transit Pass



The Low-Income Transit Pass Program provides a monthly Town of Banff transit pass **free of charge** to the following Banff residents:

- 1) Adults 18-64 years of age and their children, living under the most recently published Low Income Cut Off Level (see chart below)
- 2) All recipients of the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) program
- 3) Seniors, 65 years and older who are eligible to receive the Alberta Seniors cash benefit (see chart below)

### To apply

- Complete an application form at the Town of Banff, Community Services front desk.
- Provide the following:
  1. A copy of your 2010 “Notice of Assessment” (after filing your annual tax return, you will receive this in the mail from Revenue Canada- if you need assistance, call Revenue Canada at 1-800-959-8281.)

**AND/OR**

  2. Provide three current paystubs and proof of employment/residency for 6 months prior to date of application

**OR**

  3. AISH Health Benefit Card

**OR**

  4. If you have children, your Alberta Health Care card
  5. Personal photo identification

- If you are accepted to the program, your pass will take approximately two business days to process.

### To re-apply

- You must provide the above financial information to re-activate your transit pass for this program.
