4.0 New Business

- 4.1 Introduction of New Public Director Colin Murton
- 4.2 <u>St. Julien Road Reconstruction</u> Administration presented the background to the St. Julien Road Reconstruction project. The corporation discussed topics and locations for interpretative signage within the project area. The idea to place a blue plaque at the Caribou Street trail intersection explaining the reason for the street name of St. Julien will be developed. The Corporation will engage with Parks Canada to explore opportunities to present Indigenous history of the land at the Tunnel Mountain trailhead.

- 4.3 <u>Heritage Master Plan</u> Administration presented background and draft Request for Proposals for discussion. The Heritage Master Plan RFP will be issued with a target to have a draft Master Plan complete by the end of 2021.
- 4.4 <u>Council Updates</u> Councilor Poole provided an update to the Corporation regarding the opportunity for the Heritage Corporation to submit names for the Reserve List under the Town Naming and Sponsorship Policy; the opportunity to apply for boards and committees at the upcoming Annual Organizational Meeting; and the Town of Banff feedback to the Banff National Park Management Plan.
