May 7, 2023, 12:00 PM - 4:00 PM

Banff Train Station Parking Lot

Experience a showcase of all the crews, heavy equipment, trucks, and emergency services vehicles that keep the Bow Valley safe during a major emergency. Head to the Train Station Parking Lot on Sunday, May 7 from 12-4 p.m. and learn how agencies are prepared to deal with disasters – wildfire, flooding, severe storms, criminal attack – and more. Families will enjoy demonstrations and access to emergency vehicles, while learning how locals can take steps to be prepared for emergency. On the 10th anniversary of the major 2013 flood disaster, this event will help residents of Banff, Canmore and the Bow Valley understand disaster readiness and your role in preparing for emergencies.
